As we move into March, I'm thrilled to be providing you with updates during a busy spring at BC Lions Society for Children with Disabilities. Our team is gearing up for a packed few months preparing for a summer full of life-changing programs for children with disabilities and fundraising initiatives to support our mission.

This year we will be providing camp experiences for close to 1,000 people from all backgrounds and of all abilities. We are proud to be making a difference in not just their lives, but in their communities as well.

Our Easter Seals House continues to provide accommodation for individuals and families who must travel to Vancouver for medical needs. People travel from all corners of our province for specialized procedures and treatment only found in hospitals in Vancouver. Just in the last year, we provided over 23,000 stays for people travelling from over 200 communities in BC.
